

## **Take a tour of our App for Android™**

Now you can manage your finances right on your Android Smartphone. Our free app gives instant, secure access, whenever and wherever you need it. Just log in with the same password you use for your online account. The first time you log in you maybe prompted to get an access code as part of our process to help keep your information secure. Once you're logged in, you'll immediately see your accounts and available balances. You can simply tap the arrow to view all of your menu options anytime. Tap any account to see transaction details and simply scroll to view up to 180 days of your transaction history.

You can transfer funds right on your account history, Page 2. Or tap the arrow and then choose "Transfers" from the menu. From there, just select the accounts you'd like to transfer money to and from. Then, type the amount and tap "Transfer". You'll get a confirmation screen to make sure the right amount gets to the right account.

Tap the "Bills" button on the menu to see any payments that you've scheduled or pay a bill with just a few taps. Just select any payee you set up in your online account. Then choose the account, amount, and date. And you can even deposit a check without going to a branch or an ATM. Tap the "Deposits" button, choose an account, and enter the amount of the check. Next, snap a photo of each side of the check. Tap "Deposit" and you're done! You can also save money with cash-back offers while you're out shopping. Activate new offers when and where you need them and even get directions to the nearest store to redeem your offers right away.
